For the return of tags and catch information

Biologists have tagged walleyes in Lake Brittle as part of a statewide study. The tags will be located near the fish's dorsal fin. Anglers can remove the tags by cutting through the monofilament attachment with scissors or a knife. The fish can then be released or harvested. Return all tags and catch information to the address printed on the tag. Catch information includes: date, time and general location of catch, "Was the fish harvested or released?", "Were you fishing for walleyes?", and "Did you catch other walleyes on this fishing trip?"
