

C. F. Phelps WMA Deer Hunt for the Disabled

This is an opportunity for disabled hunters, disabled defined as mobility impaired due to a permanent physical condition, to hunt deer on the Hogue Tract of C.F. Phelps WMA in Fauquier County. Two hunters will be chosen by random drawing for each hunt day during the archery, muzzleloader, and general firearms deer seasons. Each successful applicant may be accompanied by one companion, who may hunt if properly licensed. [Applications](#) for this managed hunt must include the name, address, telephone number(s) (home, cell, and/or business), e-mail address, hunting license number, vehicle description, and vehicle license number of the disabled hunter and companion hunter/helper, and two preferred hunting dates for each season they want to hunt. Please indicate which blinds you want to hunt for each of your preferred hunting dates (There are only two choices, blinds 1 & 2 or blinds 3 & 4). Applications must be received by the close of business on September 9, 2016.

- **Hunting days:** Mondays, Wednesdays, Saturdays, and State Holidays.
- **Hunt dates archery:** October 1 through November 2, 2016
- **Hunt dates muzzleloader:** November 5 through November 16, 2016
- **Hunt dates general firearms:** November 19 through December 3, 2016
