Declaration of Possession For Domestic Red Foxes (*Vulpes vulpes*) Owned Prior to July 1, 2017

(Under Authority of Virginia Administrative Code 4 VAC 15-30-40)

Please complete the following requested information. This declaration of possession is for domesticated races of red fox (*Vulpes vulpes*) that have a coat color distinguishable from a wild red fox. **Only foxes possessed prior to 1 July 2017 may be declared and legally owned.** If more than one red fox is being declared, a separate form must be submitted for each animal. **This declaration of possession must be received no later than 1 January 2018.** Properly declared foxes may not be bred or sold without an additional permit from the Department. Possession permits must be renewed every five years and are not transferable. Please notify the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries Permit Section when a declared fox dies or is transferred out of this state.

VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND INLAND FISHERIES REQUIREMENTS FOR DECLARATION OF POSSESSION OF DOMESTIC RED FOXES OBTAINED PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2017

Under authority of Sections 29.1-103 and 29.1-521 of the Code of Virginia, it shall be unlawful to take, possess, import, cause to be imported, export, cause to be exported, buy, sell, offer for sale or liberate within the Commonwealth any wild animal unless otherwise specifically permitted by law or regulation. Effective 1 July 2017, all red foxes (*Vulpes vulpes*), regardless of their domestic origin or coloration, are legally defined as wild animals. Domesticated red foxes with a coat color distinguishable from a wild red fox possessed prior to 1 July 2017 may be maintained in captivity if they are properly declared to the Department prior to 1 January 2018. However, these foxes may not be bred or sold without a permit from the Department.

1. **NOTIFICATION:** Declaration of possession of a domesticated red fox shall be submitted in writing to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Permits Section, P O Box 3337, Henrico, VA 23228, no later than January 1, 2018. The written declaration must include the date acquired, sex, estimated age, coloration, and a color photograph of each fox (see form).
2. **TERMS:** Acknowledgement of declaration will be mailed to the owner and (i) shall serve as a permit for possession only, (ii) is not transferable, and (iii) must be renewed every five years.
3. **RENEWAL:** It shall be the responsibility of the fox owner to initiate any and all possession permit renewals.
4. **REVOCAATION:** The Department may revoke, or suspend a possession permit for failure to comply with the permit conditions listed below (4 VAC 15-290-130).

CONDITIONS OF POSSESSION PERMIT

1. Under no circumstances shall any red foxes permitted for possession be released into the wild. Permitted foxes may not be bred or sold without an additional permit from the Department.
2. **FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL LAWS:** This possession permit does not absolve the individual listed on this application of any responsibilities or conditions of any other federal, state, or local laws and regulations.
